

Michigan State University Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

MSU VITA provides tax preparation services for clients who meet low-income requirements.

General Requirements:

- Under \$54,000 in income
- Disabled
- Elderly
- Age 55 or older there is no income cap
- Wish to have help with your personal income taxes. (VITA only assists with the current year's personal income taxes. We do not assist with small business returns or those who are self-employed.

Schedule an Appointment:

Schedule an appointment by calling 2-1-1 on your local mobile or landline phone or toll free at 866-561-2500.

Bring the following documents to your appointment:

- Social Security cards for all members of the household - If you do not have your Social Security card, we can also accept form SSA-1099 if you receive Social Security benefits
- Government-issued Photo ID
- All applicable tax documentation
